SCHOOL BUSINESS:

Summer Office Hours: starting May 20th, the school office will only be open on Wednesdays to the public from 8am-1pm.

2026/2027 Health Requirement and Student Documents: reminder the following will be due next school year if you did not upload them to your enrollment packet.

- **Preschool Students:**

- Physical exam on Illinois form with updated immunization record sign by doctor and parent. Due by Oct. 15, 2026
- Copy of birth certificate. Due by Oct. 15, 2026
- Copy of baptismal certificate Due by Oct. 15, 2026
- **Kindergarten Students:**
 - Physical exam on Illinois form with updated immunization record signed by doctor and parent. Due by Oct. 15, 2025.
 - Eye exam on Illinois form due by Oct. 15, 2026.
 - Copy of birth certificate due by Oct. 15, 2026.
 - Copy of baptismal certificate due by Oct. 15, 2026.
 - Dental Exam on Illinois form due by May 15, 2026.
- **Second Grade Students:**
 - Dental exam is due by May 15, 2026.
- **Sixth Grade Students:**
 - Physical exam on Illinois form with updated immunization record signed by a doctor and a parent. Due by October 15, 2026.
 - Dental exam on Illinois due by May 15, 2027.
- **Sports Physical:**

If your child is participating in ANY sport, they must have a sports physical on file prior to the season's first practice. A school physical can be used in lieu of a sports physical; however, a sports physical **CAN NOT** be accepted as proof of a physical examination for mandated physicals. Sports physicals are valid for 395 calendar days from the date the physical was issued. IESA must have concussion info signed.

2026/2027 Service Hours: the number of service hours required by each family has increased from 10 hours to 15 hours. The fee for not meeting service hours has increased from \$10/hour to \$15/hour.

Lunch/Daycare Accounts: please make sure to check that your lunch and daycare accounts are paid by the end of the school year.

- 1 box of 8 regular size **Crayola** crayons (no florescent or “smelly” colors please)
